There were no details about the case and the police said that these rescued children were just sent from Mang Jie province where neighbouring China. Two smugglers were also arrested. As they confessed, 40 more Chinese children aged under 15 years old were transported to Xi Ning province nearby the border of Cambodia and sold to local traffickers.

BANGKOK (AP) - British actress Julia Ormond on Monday exercised her celebrity status to fight human trafficking, calling it one of the most "fantastically difficult problems we face today."

Ormond, 41, spoke in Bangkok in her capacity as United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime Goodwill Ambassador for the Abolition of Slavery and Trafficking, a position she has held since December.

Ormond opened a three-day regional conference on human trafficking, a crime which has a low profile but is particularly widespread in Southeast Asia, and lauded the social workers, government officials and other experts in the field.

Caretaker Social Development and Human Security Minister Watana Muangsook addressed the seminar, stressing Thailand's awareness on human trafficking in the Indochina and its endless efforts to end it.

Malaysian women rescued from London sex ring

LONDON: Nineteen Malaysian women were rescued from two brothels during a pre-dawn crackdown on a multi-million ringgit human-trafficking racket.

Thirteen of the women were found in a six-bedroom townhouse in Hyde Park, west London, and six others in another brothel in Birmingham. A source said they were Malaysians aged between 19 and 25.

Police described the case as the largest number of sex trafficking victims involving Malaysians rescued in a single operation.

越南南部胡志明市警方 10 日从一个人口走私集团手中解救了 3 名男孩和 1 名女孩,这些孩子年龄在 9 岁到 14 岁之间。警方没有透露细节,只是说获救孩子刚从越南北部与中国相邻的芒街省被带到胡志明市。警方还逮捕了两名人口走私集团的成员。据犯罪嫌疑人供认,此前他们一共走私了 40 名 15 岁以下的中国儿童。这些儿童被运送到了靠近柬埔寨边界的西宁省,交给了当地的人贩子。
