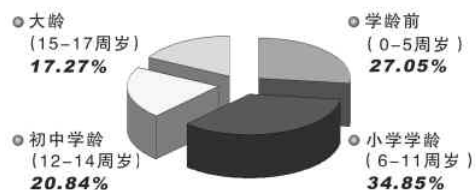
All China's Women's Federation: Rural stay-at-home children make up the second largest number of trafficked children

China Web, 27 February 2008: According to the *Research Report on the Situation of Rural Stay-At-Home Children*, of all the trafficked children, stay-at-home children make up the second largest number. The Report also points out that many guardians only paid occasional attention or taken occasional actions to prevent stay-at-home children from harm. According to the relevant ministries and departments, of all the trafficked children, migrating children represent the largest number of victims, followed by the stay-at-home children. In addition, some of the older stay-at-home

Xinhua Web, 27 February 2008: All China's Women's Federation held a press conference in Beijing to publicise the results from its sampling survey on the family and educational situation of minors as well as its national research on rural stay-at-home children. The latter reports more than 1 stay-at-home child to every 4 rural children. According to the national sampling survey conducted in 2005 where 1% of the total population was selected, out of the 58 million rural stay-at-home children, there are around 40 million under 14 years of age. Compared to 2000, the number of stay-at-home children had grown rapidly. The stay-at-home children represents 28.29% of the total rural children in China.

People Web & ACWF News, 27 February 2009: The Ministry of Justice provided suggestions for strengthening the protection of stay-at-home and migrating children during the press conference on national research of rural stay-at-home children. According to the spokesperson, preventing the trafficking of children amongst migrating and stay-at-home children is a vital issue. In addition to enhancing the education of guardians and parents on their responsibilities, there is also a need to provide to children legal information, safety information, self-protection and self-defence education.

The 'Federation of Workers' Unions' has now covered 1394 towns, and has allowed the protection of rights to be extended to the forgotten corners. In addition, the total number of union members has increased from 5.7 million last year to the current 6.24 million.

查和全国农村留守儿童状况调查发布会。报告指出，平均每四个农村儿童中就有一个多留守儿童。根据 2005 年全国 1%人口抽样调查的抽样数据推断，全国农村留守儿童约 5800 万人，其中 14 周岁以下的农村留守儿童约 4000 多万。和 2000 年相比，2005 年的农村留守儿童规模增长十分迅速。在全部农村儿童中，留守儿童的比例达 28.29%。(2008 年 02 月 27 日 作者：马丽娜 来源：新华网)
